2021 Arizona Women's Partnership Grant

During the year 2021, we were able to continue providing uninterrupted crucial crisis services including counseling and despite the pandemic, or perhaps in response to it, we actually received an increase in requests for services. We provided virtual, telephonic and in person crisis and therapeutic counseling sessions to victims of crimes and traumatized women and children. Our numbers increased due to several components, but crime tends to increase in a time of uncertainty and fear. Many of the families we served suffered traumatizing events. Once again, due to the generous donation received through the Arizona Women's Partnership, Inc., we offered crisis services and therapeutic sessions by our trained advocates and licensed therapist who specializes in trauma. H.A.V.E.N. Family Resource Center was able to provide 198 hours of counseling sessions and 375 hours of crisis counseling to women and children. Of these statistics – 55% (315) are Caucasian; 23% (131) are Native American; 20% (114) are Hispanic; 2% (13) are African American.

As the New Year begins, we hope for peace and wellbeing for all, but we will continue to provide assistance to families in need with crisis response, victim advocacy, case management, follow up care and therapeutic counseling services to help our communities deal with crisis and trauma.
