On behalf of Angel Heart Pajama Project, I would like to express my sincere appreciation for your ongoing support during the past years. You have been very generous in providing grants to be able to purchase new pajamas for children in need.

In 2022 and 2023 Angel Heart gifted over 7,300 pairs of pajamas to children who were living in foster care, safe houses, shelters, being treated at children's hospitals or medical facilities, receiving food subsidies through local food banks, or who were attending HeadStart Preschools.

The purpose of Angel Heart is to help every child feel cared about by others, and we want them to know they are loved and special. Arizona Women's Partnership was instrumental in realizing our purpose.

Meet the Lions Club Members of South Tucson and the Cyber Lions of Tucson who provide free eye exams and lenses to children in need. Angel Heart has partnered with both clubs to help do eye screening and also to provide the children with new pajamas and books.

Meet Joe, a Domestic Violence Detective with the Tucson Police Department. Joe learned about Angel Heart when his wife organized a Pajama Drive. He visited Angel Heart's warehouse and learned about the work of Angel Heart and its far-reaching efforts to ensure children in need receive new, warm, cozy pajamas to make them feel comfortable and bring a smile to their faces. Now Joe and his fellow officers on the force receive pajamas for the children they work with during the year.

Meet the Tucson's Sun Tran Bus employees delivering pajamas and books to 12 agencies on their route, who will distribute them to kids and help put a smile on each one!



Angel Heart's primary mission is to serve children in need who live in distressed situation and under very difficult circumstances. In addition, we strive to create community partnerships in order to do more outreach to best meet the needs of the children.
